The Suburb's twin in France, the delightful Parisian suburb of Le Vesinet has a number of young people who would like to arrange exchanges with the Suburb. They include:



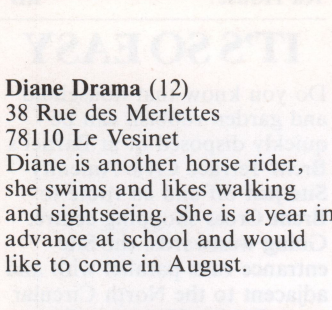

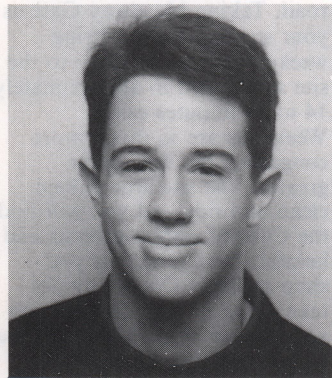

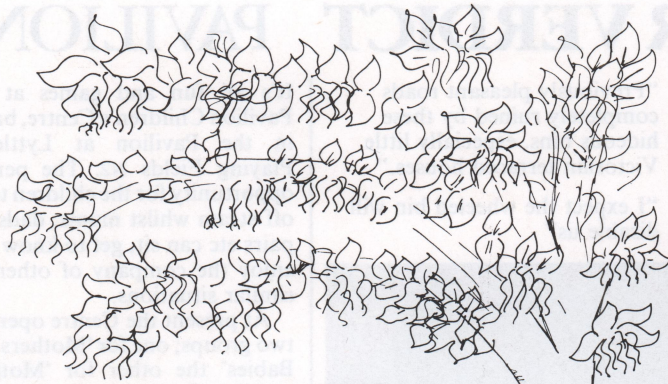
