ST JUDES RECORDING THREAT

Two separate things are happening over the threat to St Judes Church income from recordings. Firstly the original Barnet Council enforcement notice, which put forward numerous grounds for complaint, has been withdrawn. A new enforcement notice was issued on 12th March just dealing with traffic considerations. An appeal to the Department of the Environment has been lodged. There will eventually be a public enquiry.

P.C.C. appointed David Baker Architects, who applied for planning consent for the occasional recording. Discussions are in hand with the Barnet officers and councillors and considerable help and support is being obtained from the Residents Association and the Trust. As the only ground of complaint is a narrow technical traffic matter it is quite possible for the local councillors to overrule their traffic officer at the area planning committee if they wish to do so.
