

St Jude's Autumn Market

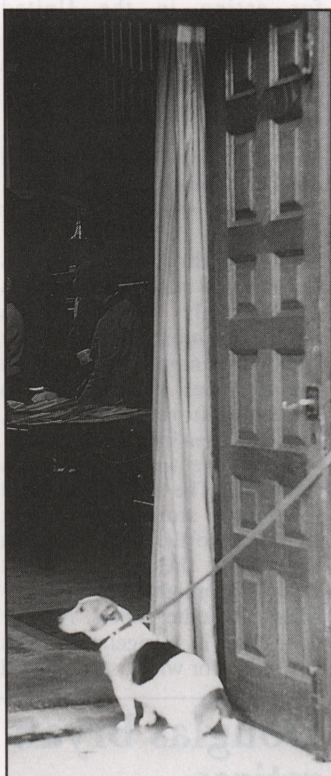
It was a case of taking refuge from the weather for St Jude's Autumn Market on October 2.
