Chairman's introduction to the Annual Report for 1997-98

We are very sorry to report the deaths in the past year of David Bedford-Smith and Kit Ikin, both very involved in the formation of this Trust and amongst the original trustees. We hope to publish a second edition of Kit Ikin's fascinating Suburb history in the near future. Other losses to us this year include Stuart Grey, an architect long involved in the Suburb's overall appearance and individual buildings and also Lord MacGregor, an earlier Trust Chairman.

Sound financial basis

The accounts for the year show anticipated reductions in both revenue and expenses. Taken with the returns on our investment portfolio, the Trust continues to operate on a sound financial basis.

Improving the Suburb

Our charitable status and cost containment have allowed us to increase both charitable grants and spending on improving amenities within the Suburb. These payments are mainly handled through the Grants sub-committee, under the able chairmanship of John Freeborn.

No increase in charge

Cost control has enabled us to avoid any increase in the management charge for freeholders next year.

Help for Suburb amenities

We have continued our policy of providing or subsidising worthwhile amenities for the Suburb. These include continuing restoration of green spots in the area, the Suburb Gallery and sponsorship for the St Jude's Proms.

Thanks to members

As ever, I would like to thank my fellow Council members who voluntarily provide for us all the benefit of their time, energy and expertise. Thanks are due, too, to the hard working staff at the Trust's offices.

New architect sought

David Pickles, the Trust architect, will be moving shortly to a post with English Heritage after over two years of competent and professional work with us. At the time of writing, we have a short list of excellent candidates for this post and I feel sure that we will be able to appoint a successor who will fill this role very well.

Chris Kellerman, as always, manages both to run the day to day affairs of the Trust and also to take a longer term view of the Suburb's needs
