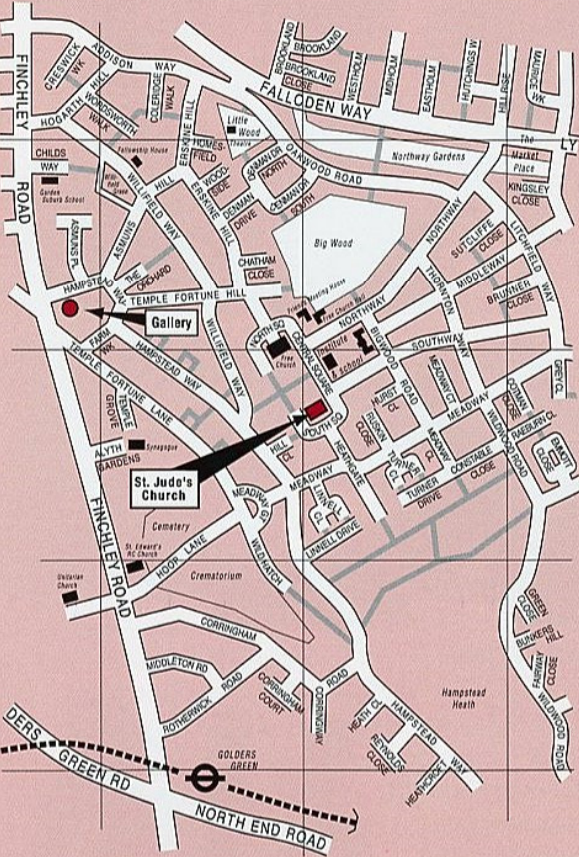


HOW TO GET TO ST JUDE'S

You can travel by bus or tube to Golders Green Station (Northern Line). From here it is a pleasant 15-minute walk to St Jude's.

Alternatively take the frequent H2 bus service from Golders Green station to Heathgate, approximately 50 yards from the church.

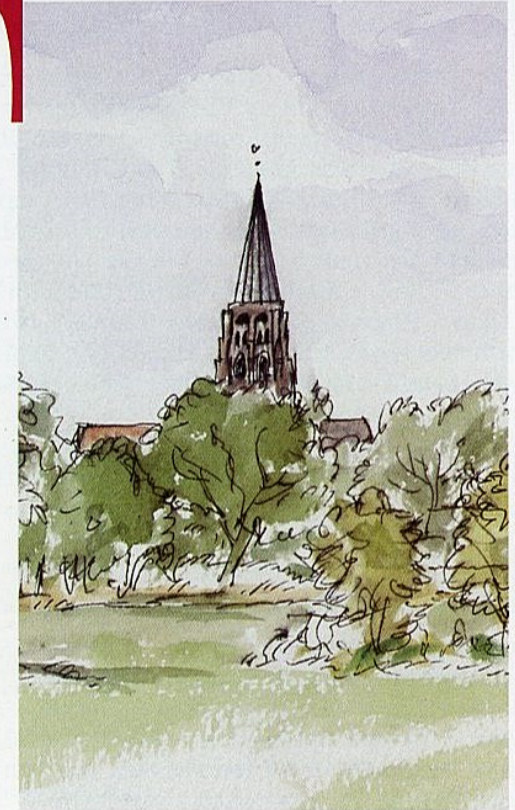

Each walk costs just £5 which includes a complimentary Proms programme and coffee on arrival at the church. Advance booking is advisable as numbers are limited.

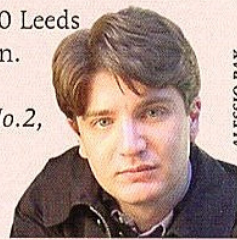

Student Promenaders: Tickets £3 at the door (max 30 standing only)

Reserved seating: all reserved seating is upholstered, numbered and in the main body of the church.

Unreserved seating: on a 'first come, first served' basis, this seating is neither upholstered nor numbered. Seats are placed down the side aisles and at the rear of the church. Some of seating has restricted views, so early arrival is recommended.

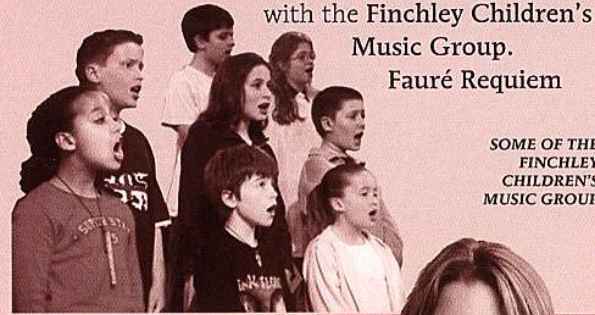

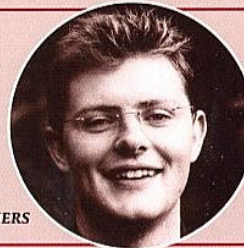
