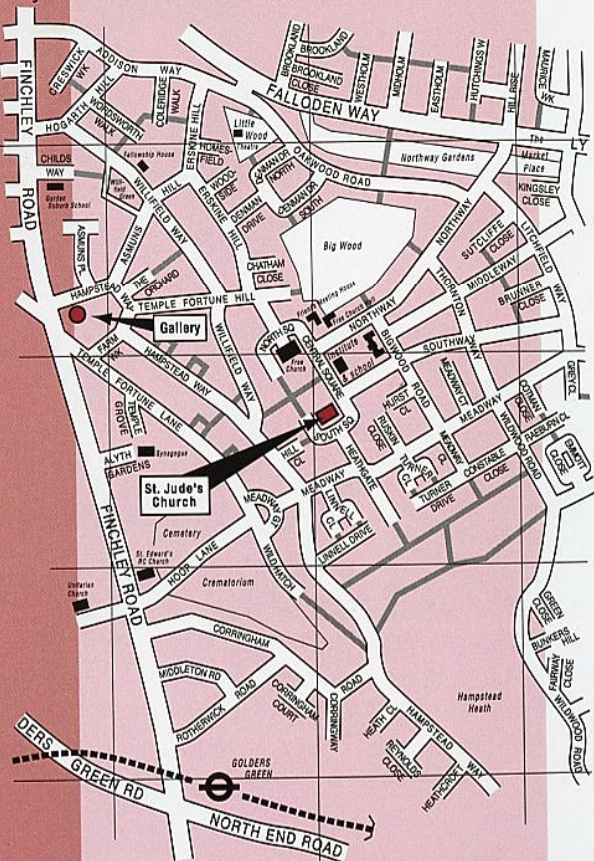


HOW TO GET TO ST JUDE'S

You can travel by bus or tube to Golders Green Station (Northern Line). From here it is a pleasant 15-minute walk to St Jude's.

Alternatively take the frequent H2 bus service from Golders Green station to Heathgate, approximately 50 yards from the church.

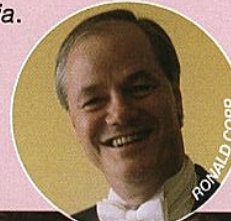

Seating is classified as Premium (front and rear) and Unnumbered. Premium seating is upholstered, numbered and in the main body of the church. Unnumbered seats are wooden and are placed down the side aisles and at the rear. Some of these seats have restricted views, so early arrival is recommended – bring a cushion!

Promenader tickets: £3 at the door (max 30 standing only).

Discounts: Party bookings (10 or more) - 10% off.
Book three or more concerts - 10% off.

Concessions: £2 off at the door on the night only.

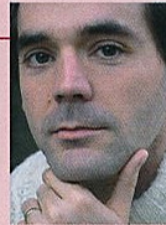
