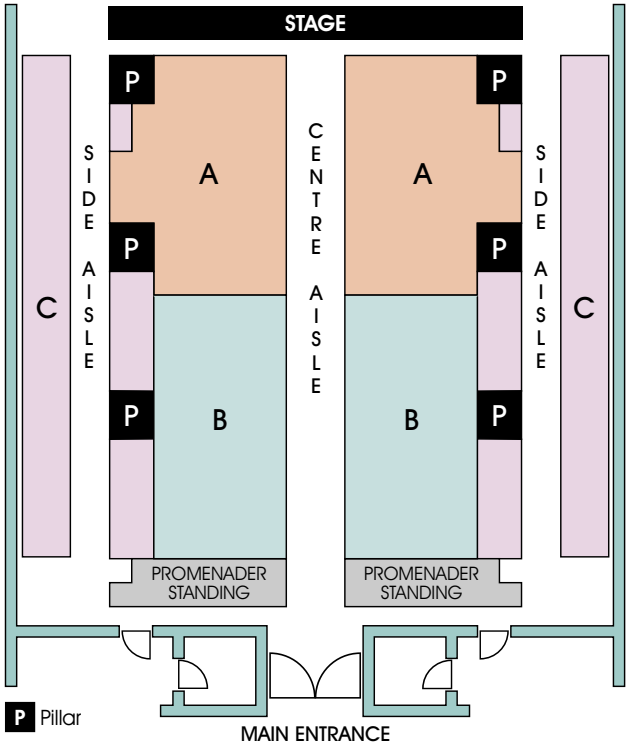

Seating

Seating is classified as **Premium** (front **A**, rear **B**) and **Unnumbered C**. Premium seating is upholstered, numbered and in the main body of the church. Unnumbered seats are wooden and are placed down the side aisles and at the rear. Some of these seats have restricted views, so early arrival is recommended – bring a cushion!

Lunchtime concerts: FREE (Doors open 12 noon, unreserved seats)

Promenader tickets: £3 at the door (max 30 standing only).

Discounts: Party bookings (10 or more) - 10% off.

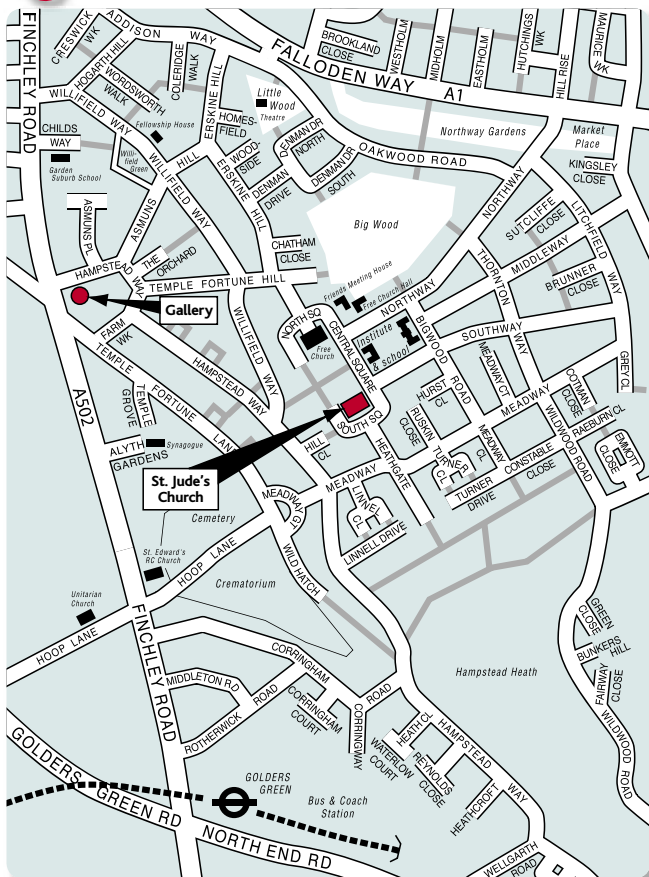
