

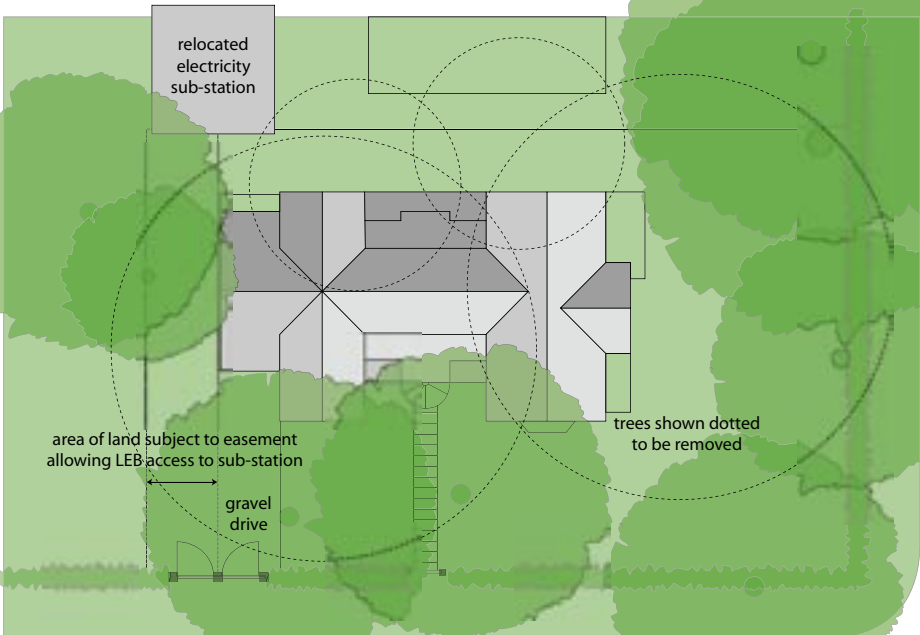
Gallery show helps Hospice



The exhibition of work by Jennie Dunn culminates on Sunday 8 May between 11 and 3 with a last opportunity to meet the artist, enjoy a glass of wine and purchase prints and paintings which will benefit the North London Hospice.

Up to 100% of some prints, which start at £30, and a generous proportion of all sales go to the charity. Jennie Dunn's exuberant work is followed in the Gallery, at the Temple Fortune end of Hampstead Way, with a Spring show of flowers in oils, watercolours and etchings from Suburb artists to suit all tastes and pockets.

The HGS Residents Association welcomes a new chairman and vice-chairman and hopes that their both being David Lewis will not lead to too much confusion.

Chairman David Lewis lives in Wildwood Rise. He and his wife Susan moved there from Hampstead in 1994. They have been married for 35 years and have two sons who were educated at King Alfred's.

David is a retired publisher and financial journalist. He has written a number of financial books and for ten years edited the Daily Mail's Money Mail. He joined the RA council in 1997 and has been a very effective Chairman of the Conservation and Amenities committee for six years. "That is the main area of my work for the RA," he says, "aiming to preserve the quality of the physical environment we live in. Our most recent success was the reinstatement of traditional street name signs."

An innovator, David had the idea of the Suburb email discussion list which was implemented by Steve Morris as part of his Suburb website. With about 150 members, and growing, it allows residents to discuss matters of common interest with others they might never otherwise meet. David also organised the two '60s Discos last year that raised £5000 for local charities.

David Lewis Vice Chairman was born on the Suburb, he was a small spear carrier in one of the pre-war pageants and belonged to the 1st Golders Green cubs, scouts and rovers. He later played rugby for the London

Welsh for eight years. His wife Sally, also a Suburb native, taught at the Garden Suburb School and is on Trees and Open Spaces. They live in Northway from where Sally can keep an eye on Northway Gardens. They have three children and eight grandchildren. Their sons and daughter were educated locally

at Brookland Schools and Whitefield Comprehensive. David has been a Whitefield's governor for 25 years and is currently the chairman. He has been on the RA's Consam committee for five years, is a Trustee for the the Friends of the Orchard and is an active member of the local North London Hospice Support Group.
